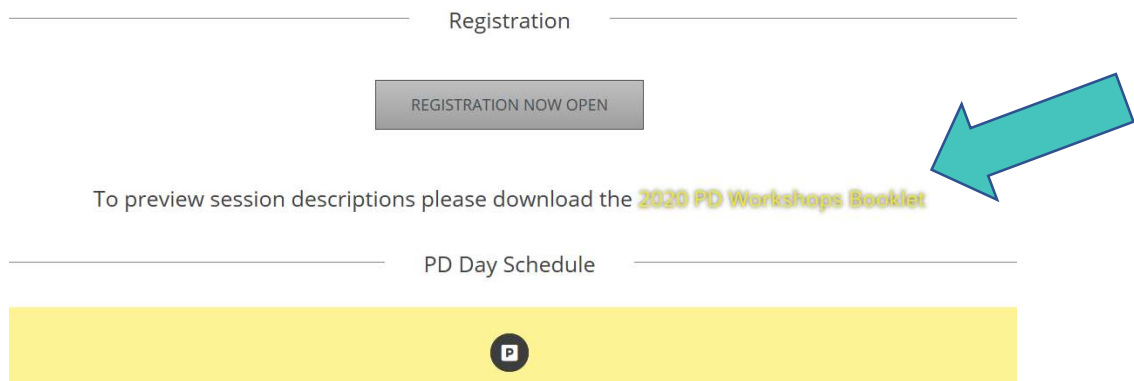


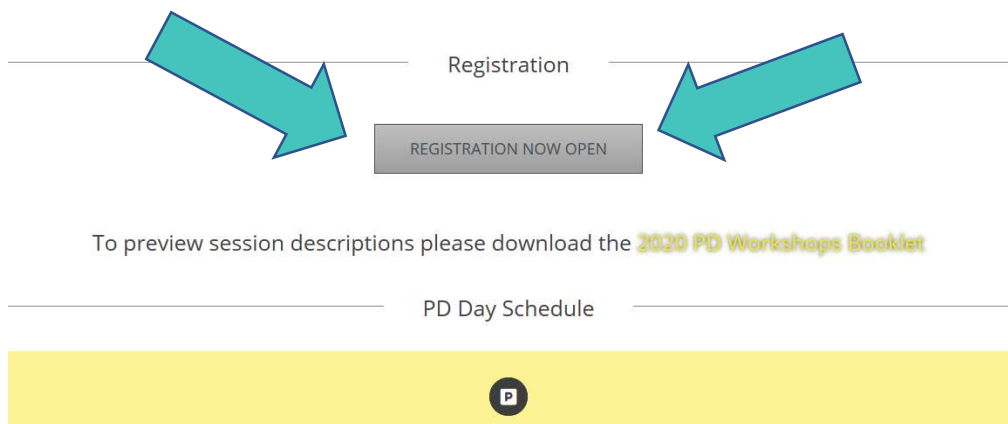
Beyond Words: Taking Action

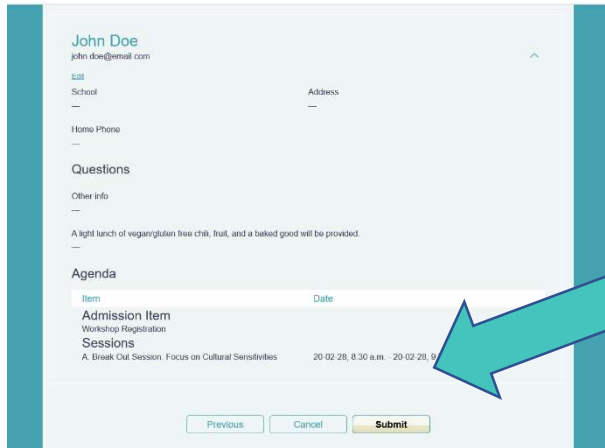

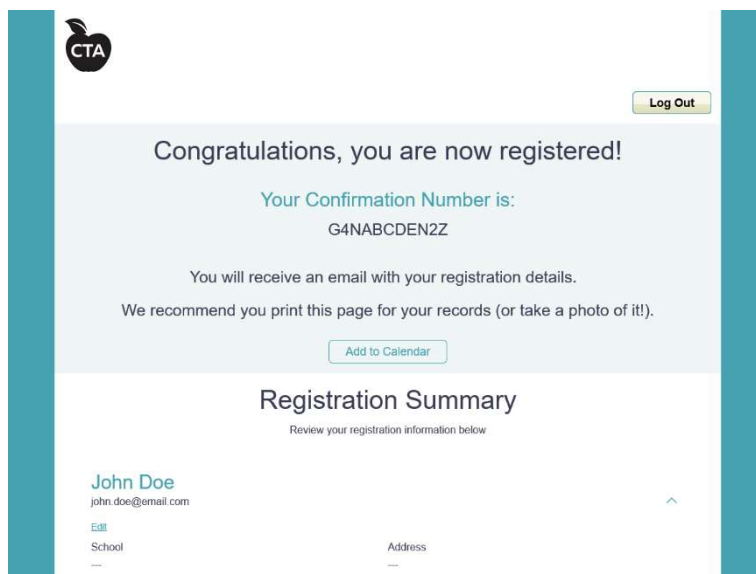
