First Vice-President's Message Dear colleagues,

We hope summer gave you some much needed time to relax and reconnect with loved ones!

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It has been a very different looking back to school year than we have ever had before. Along with the excitement of seeing colleagues and students, there have also been concerns of what teaching looks like in this new reality we find ourselves in. Advocacy continues both locally and provincially as the BCTF continues to engage with the Ministry about reducing classroom density, stricter mask policies, and the creation of a COVID leave. Locally, we remain in frequent contact with the employer to keep on top of arising issues, address concerns, and problem solve. Schools may be experiencing some re-organization as student attendance is solidified over the coming days as a result of new student registrations, or a migration of students to homeschool or distance learning programs. September is still a flex month for class size in regards to remedy.

By now, health and safety protocols for each school site should have been shared and each site's plan submitted yesterday to the employer. Teachers should have received their masks and may request a face shield. More face mask shipments will probably be coming.

Even though site Joint Occupational Health and Safety Committees regularly meet in a normal year, it will be very important to fill these committee spots and have a robust, engaged committee. Training sessions for new members will be made available and we highly encourage new members to take advantage of this opportunity.

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If a teacher becomes aware of a workplace hazard or a health and safety issue, the teacher must follow process and report to their administrator first and can also take their concern to the Joint Occupational Health and Safety Committee to help problem solve.

AIC UPDATE

PAYMENT OF PROFESSIONAL FEES

We received a clarification from the mediator on the issue of reimbursement of professional fees for members who are speech language pathologists and school psychologists. As this new provincial provision came into effect on July 1, 2020, these members are eligible for reimbursement of their current professional fees based on the following clarification:

School psychologists—are entitled to be reimbursed for half (1/2) of their current fees for the 6 month period of July 1 to December 31, 2020.

Their next professional fee is due by December 31, 2020 for the next calendar year, when it will be fully reimbursed on an ongoing basis.

Speech language pathologists—are entitled to be reimbursed for three-quarters (¾) of their current fees for the period of July 1, 2020 to March 31, 2021.

Their next professional fee is due by March 31, 2021 for the following school year, when it will be fully reimbursed on an ongoing basis.

NOTE: These fees will not be submitted by employers to the respective governing bodies, but will be **reimbursed to members upon submission of proof of payment**. This provision is in addition to any allowances that these members currently receive as per local collective agreement language.
