President's Message

September 30th Truth and Reconciliation Day

The CTA is encouraging school staffs to recognize Truth and Reconciliation Day at some point before the Thursday on which it falls. The CTA also asks that you take some time on the day to consider the circumstances Indigenous people face in Canada and the injustices imposed upon them historically and those which continue today. It is certainly hoped that the Province gets on with the job of officially recognizing this day and with the work of Reconciliation they need to participate in.

Covid, Data and Protocols

The CTA remains frustrated by the lack of clear data from the Health Authority regarding cases in schools. We can see from the public data that cases among school-aged children are on the rise but the argument continues that schools are safe places and transmissions are low. It's hard to verify such things when the Health Authority won't share data with us to confirm or deny. They claim also that there is just a "change in mechanism" but not a reduction in contact tracing, which doesn't make sense to us and it's hard to understand how contact tracing will still happen when the data on exposures isn't being shared. Ongoing from that is still an unwillingness to involve teachers more broadly in contact tracing. With reduced rules around gathering and social distancing, you would think it would be even more essential to ask the person who knows where all the kids were. Frustration also continues provincially with the Steering Committee seeming to be less effective at getting changes made and work done. The BCTF is the only party at the table asking questions, the other partners seem to see it as an affirmation session to tell them they are doing ok. We have numerous assertions from the School District around continued data sharing, (Fraser Health permitting), ongoing cleaning, limiting access, mask exemption protocols, etc. And that's great but, it would be helpful if the Health Authority committee to similar assurances and action.
