President's Message

Bargaining

Just a brief update on the status of Bargaining, locally and provincially. Locally, we have set some dates for bargaining and will be meeting with our Bargaining Committee shortly to develop objectives and language. Provincially, there will be a Bargaining Conference at the end of October to develop Provincial objectives and instruct the Provincial team on what to seek in bargaining. Previous to that, there will be a BCTF Zone Meeting, which will also contribute to the discussion, in a small way.

Surplus in Schools

I had some concern with the way things were shaping up over the summer, that we would be looking at a somewhat significant level of September surplus. Nothing at all like what happened last year, which was driven by unprecedented Covid-based drawdowns of International Ed work but, a little bit larger than the expected level for Sept. I am pleased to report that thus far, there are fewer schools in surplus than anticipated. Also, there are far more schools opening divisions than losing them so, people surplussed will land safely. It's still disruptive and upsetting but, at least there is ample work to hand out. High school remains a work in progress, as it's a bit more complex than Elementary and Middle and high schools can often absorb a surplus internally, as many did last year. Members concerned about service (non-enrolling) support should know that this won't be determined until a little later, as 1701 numbers firm and needs-based assessments by Learning Services are completed.



Kim was a long time teacher and coach at Centennial Secondary. A Celebration of Life is planned for September 12, 2021, <u>for details please click here.</u>




COMMITTEE FOR ACTION ON SOCIAL JUSTICE
