

President's Message

Extreme Weather

Again, we are facing an extreme weather event in BC. We've had heat domes, fires, tornados and, now, massive flooding. While we seem generally spared the worst of it here in the Tri Cities, many teachers who live or work in the Valley are having their lives turned upside down right now. I've been checking in with my friends who live out there and what they are reporting is pretty harrowing stuff. You have all no doubt seen the pictures and video out there in the media. Fortunately, there have thus far been only reports of a few deaths and we hope that continues.

We have had reports of some school damage here locally, mostly flooding that resulted in a couple early releases. Something to be aware of from the collective agreement is a local provision that covers teacher personal property loss. The provisions of this article require that each personal item be registered at the office and that the teacher carry a personal homeowner insurance policy and the item is not covered by that policy. The maximum compensation is \$500. This language is really old, dating back the late 1980s, as you can tell from some of the language and numbers here. It's an example of another local provision frozen in time due to the split of issues.

We hope everyone in our community is safe and their families too, as we continue to deal with these unprecedented problems. Our door is always open to discuss options with anyone from our community that is affected.
