Bargaining Documents

A reminder to all, following up on a recent staff rep bulletin, that there are documents up on our website regarding the conclusion of local bargaining. Please take the time to review the agreed-upon clauses and changes. There was active discussion and bargaining always involves some give and take. Members are free to ask questions of us. We are looking at information sessions down the road and there will need to be a ratification vote. We plan to hold the vote later in this year.

EFAP Provider Change

The contract for the employer's EFAP provider came up and there is a change in that provider, which many will no doubt welcome. There was only one company that responded to the Request For Proposal, Homewood Health. They offer a similar short-term focused support model as other providers and, they are honest about that. The change will take effect March 1st, 2022. Anyone using the current provider, Morneau-Shepell (Lifeworks) will be able to continue to the natural end of their service provision, as well as new requests, until March 1, will be fulfilled by the current provider. The employer will be sending out information on the new provider and their services shortly.

Changes to Pacific Blue Cross Coverage

As of January 1, 2022, Pacific Blue Cross has updated their policy regarding reasonable and customary (R&C) limits for the costs of paramedical services such as physiotherapy, massage therapy, etc. As the costs of these services are increasing for members, PBC has increased the amount they will cover per visit. Check your Caresnet account for more info.
