5 Days' Paid Sick Leave

This item is for TTOCs, as contract teachers have superior sick leave provisions. This change comes via the Employment Standards Act and, although TTOCs were initially excluded, this has been rectified now, due to BCTF and Local Association advocacy. Unfortunately, the Government did not see fit to attach any additional resources to fund this so, the costs roll downhill to the School Districts. The employer here hopes to have their systems up and running shortly so this can work through CADS. We will keep members apprised of progress in this area. We invite TTOCs to call and discuss this with us, particularly if they find themselves in need of this time.


