Municipal Elections - October 15, 2022

There are competitions for positions in two of the three municipalities and it is important that candidates who share our values in public education get selected for these positions. It can be hard sometimes to get information on individual candidates in local elections but, because voter turnout is often low, a few votes can really make a difference. We strongly recommend involvement in local elections.

PD Power



As the stacks of yellow forms for October 21 sit impatiently beside me it seems like a good time to explain some of the CTA policy that governs the use of these funds. Every teacher in our district, including TTOCs, is eligible for two completed yellow forms between May 1 and April 30 of each year. The yellow form covers events or workshops that are not credit granting and that do not lead to certifications. For registration costs the formula for reimbursement is: 100% of the first \$80 and up to half of the remainder. For registration costs we cannot reimburse any taxes, booking fees, or food or parking costs. Accommodation costs provide \$30 reimbursement for each night that is necessary for attendance at the event (i.e. we can't provide reimbursement for any extra days you choose to stay) and transportation provides \$30 for driving outside of Hope or Whistler. If you're flying, the yellow form can reimburse ¼ of the base fare (no fees or taxes) of your flight. All these values are set out in policy 9 of the CTA Bylaws and Policies. If you're ever uncertain of how much reimbursement you would get for a certain event, please send me an email and I'm happy to do the math before you decide whether to register.


