## **President's Message**

I want to speak on behalf of the CTA and let the membership know that we are aware the TTOC shortage situation (otherwise known as "failure to fill") is the most significant impact on teacher wellness going on right now. We have been involved with the employer on troubleshooting solutions and many have been implemented. The foundational and most difficult to resolve issue is that this is a supply side problem. Not enough teachers are being graduated, due to many factors (cost, difficulty of the work, low starting salary, etc.) and, you can't fish an empty pond. Despite the highly competitive circumstances, recruitment does continue locally. Challenges lately have been exacerbated by overworked TTOCs getting sick as well, which we completely understand. Hopefully, the additional salary in the new agreement (if ratified) will attract some new people to this profession but, that is no quick fix. We have discussed extensively the employer's recruitment and retention plans and actions and have made many suggestions to help them here. They've come up with some innovative ideas of their own, as well, to be fair. We will be meeting with them again this week to discuss it at our Labour Relations meeting, where we will again have concrete suggestions to make to aid this situation. We are deeply sympathetic to the plight educators are in and we hope our efforts will make a real difference here.

# Systemic Racism in Policing from a Human Rights Lens

November 24, 2022 | 5:00-6:00pm PST

The time for debate about whether systemic racism exists in policing is over—particularly, but not exclusively, as it effects Indigenous and Black people in British Columbia. It is time to act. In fall 2021, BC's Office of the Human Rights Commissioner released the most comprehensive analysis of policing and arrest data in B.C.'s history, alongside recommendations about reforms to address the disturbing pattern of discrimination revealed. In her talk, Commissioner Govender will speak about the report and her ongoing calls for immediate and sustained action to reform policing in BC.
