





The CTA stands with the student teachers of the Carmen Serdan Rural Teacher College in the northeast part of the state of Puebla, in Mexico.

These teachers have suffered oppression by the government of Mexico, trying to starve them out of existence to continue the wave of privatization of education in Mexico. These teachers are all women, with representation from indigenous peoples, as well.

These teacher colleges have been a beacon of hope and freedom to rural people in Mexico since 1910 and are a legacy of the Mexican revolution.

The CTA has committed some of its own resources as a donation to help these teachers survive this onslaught by the government of Mexico. We encourage our members and the general public to offer their own support to the cause these teachers represent.


