President's Message

Retro Pay

We have been taking many questions down here on retro pay, now that the contract is ratified. Honestly, we approached Payroll the morning after ratification to address this issue. We asked if Payroll could get this retro pay done within December. Payroll assures us that they can do that. How December pay works is you get an advance on the 15th and the month end pay on the last day, which, in this case is the 16th. So, the retro pay will be included on the 16th pay and the advance adjusted to reflect the different value of the percentage advanced. As a reminder, the adjustment to the grid is \$427 at each step and then 3.24% on the total, after that is added. New salary grids are up on the BCTF website, here:




