President's Message

Teacher Shortage

By now, we are all aware there is a supply-side problem in teaching. Simply not enough people are graduating as new teachers. This is putting stress on the entire system and throwing school districts into deep competition with each other for a small pool of new teachers. This deficit has been a problem that more remote districts have faced for years, due to fewer people wanting to live in more remote communities. This has led some of these school boards to adopt policies that place non-certified people in teaching positions. Down in the Lower Mainland, we've been more insulated from this, as most people live down here in BC and want to work somewhere local. The current deficit of new teachers coming out of initial teacher education programs has prompted the Chilliwack School District to hire non-certified teachers and, they are the first lower Mainland District to do so. We hold the position here that we don't want non-certs in our classrooms and the employer agrees with us on this. It undermines qualifications generally and diminishes the value of certifications that people worked hard to get, as well as posing a significant quality of instruction problem. The expansion of this non-cert trend into the Lower Mainland is gravely concerning to us and we will remain vigilantly opposed to it, should it move west.

On a brighter note, there have been two recent orientations for new teachers locally and we have run our New Teacher School Union Rep Training in the wake of that. We had our first session yesterday and it was full, as are the subsequent two that we have planned for the following weeks. These events build member engagement and connection to this learning community, which is a key retention strategy.

How Well Do You Know Your Collective Agreement?

Our intent in this section of the newsletter is to help SD43 teachers become more familiar with their collective agreement. Each week we will list an article below with a link to our Collective Agreement. The onus is on the employee to be aware of their contractual rights.

This week's article: **G.20 (1)(a-n) - Leaves of Absence** Section 1 on G.20 deals with general leave provisions that are paid leaves. Leaves in this section include things like Writing Exams, Court Attendance, Care of Child/Dependent parent to name a few. Each of these has specific language and some are pro-rated based on FTE. Our advice is to apply for leaves well in advance.
