

1971

JUNE 3

CTA adopts the New Constitution to allow incorporation.

CTA is a Society registered with the Registrar of Companies.

1973

MAY 31

CTA organizes 1st Pro-D Day. Established 6-member Pro-D Committee elected and 9 member Status of Women Committee.

AGM delegates will be elected by a General Meeting in January or February.

1974-1975

Public Relations Committee becomes a CTA Standing Committee.

1978

JUNE 7

Expressed concern to Board over use of temporary teacher appointments instead of offering a continuing contract

1979

JUNE 6

Rallied support from local public sector unions and B.C. Federation of Labour against indexing limits to pensions.

Rallies in Victoria held on June 16th, 1980.

10% of budget will be allotted for contingency fund.

1980

JUNE 4

Established PSA Council and detailed policies for Pro-D Committee and introduction of the yellow Pro-D assistance forms.

CTA will work with Board to develop a District report card and opposed the use of letter grades for 8-12 yr olds.

1981

JUNE 3

Sought for bargaining of all conditions of employment in the upcoming contract negotiations (Fall 1982).


Took part in the province-wide withdrawal of service as part of action against the legislation and budget. Language agreed to for layoff and recall of teachers

NOVEMBER




BCTF engaged in a two-week strike, deemed illegal by the courts which led to a mediated settlement.

2005

FALL

BCTF voted to join the Canadian Labour Congress (March)

Collective agreement reached between the government and BCTF (June)



2006

MARCH

Teaching Profession Act was passed

Collective agreement ratified.



2011

JUNE 3

2007

MARCH

The Teachers' Act, Bill 12, was passed in 2011. It dissolved the College of Teachers and established the Teacher Regulation Branch and the Teachers' Council.

BC Supreme Court declared the 2002 legislation invalid and gave the government a year to remedy the situation

2012

MARCH

BC teachers held a 3-day strike action

BCTF took a province-wide strike vote and began a limited job action which led to rotating strikes in May with a full strike by mid-June.

Settlement finally reached on September 14, 2014.

2014

MARCH

Supreme Court of Canada ruling in Nov. 2016 returned language illegally stripped by the government in 2002.

Layoff and recall were eliminated.

1st year of revised curriculum K-9 implementation.

2017

MAY 17

Action in Victoria to lobby delegates at NDP Convention re: Jackson arbitrations (special ed designations)

2019

NOVEMBER 23

Covid-19 pandemic turned in-person schooling into emergency online remote learning.

Local and provincial deal reached.

MAY 10

Year end meeting and CTA 50th Anniversary Celebration! Presented honorary memberships.
