President's Message

Demonstration Follow Up

It does appear that there will be another multi-city anti-SOGI demonstration this month, Oct 21, 1-4. As such, we are asking members who feels strongly about this issue and want to participate and take action against all the misinformation and lies around SOGI123 and the 2SLGBTQIA+ community to meet for resistance on that day. We suggest meeting at City Hall again, as we did on Sept. 20. Please make the choices that are safe for you on participation. The CTA supports diversity and inclusion in the classroom and will stand by those beliefs without question, any time, anywhere. We do not condone hate or the parsing of human rights out from any community, great or small. We will defend human rights for all with every means at our disposal. We will not allow marginalized communities to be characterized as a problem to be solved by people lacking any understanding of the needs of those communities. We will stand up for students and their families in opposing this hateful, ignorant and targeted rhetoric.

AP Extension

The large number (17) of Administrative Procedures dropped on teachers for review at the start of the school year prompted a conversation on workload. While we understand the employer can create policies and procedures and has an obligation to share those with employees, it can't be avoided that some of these policies are ten-plus pages long and are dense with legalese. There is A LOT going on for teachers at the start of the school year and it isn't reasonable to ask them to be fully clear on all of these in less than 3 weeks. Hence, we asked for and have been granted an extension until the end of October, so people can familiarize themselves with these policies and procedures. Note that most of the procedures are not new or been changed, they have been in place for some time now.
