

Take a moment to ensure the BCTF has your current non-SD43 email address so you receive your personal voting link.

Voting links will be sent to Non-SD43 email addresses after 11 pm this Thursday, November 2, 2023. The email will be sent from "British Columbia Teachers' Federation (Local 43 – Coquitlam Teachers' Association)" with the email address vote@simplyvoting.com.

Your link is specific to you and will allow you to vote after voting opens at 7:00 am on November 3, 2023.

You will not be able to vote until voting opens!

When you click your personalized link, you will be taken to your electronic ballot where you can vote on the motions.

Once you vote, you will then be asked to confirm your selection.

If you want to change your vote, click "change." If your selection was correct, click "confirm."



A message was sent from the BCTF; Many of you are probably already aware that on Friday, October 20, 2023, the Provincial Specialist Associations that were hosting their online conferences through easyREG, suffered a catastrophic failure of their conference platform.

Many were already prepared for this eventuality and managed to find alternate ways to get the session links to their participants. Others found that the methods they had prepared were stymied by a variety of factors beyond their control, one of the most frustrating of which was the tendency of district email filters to flag their emails to members as spam.

The PSAs are run by volunteer BCTF members. These are full time teachers who pour their hearts and souls into the running of their PSAs and the professional development (PD) they provide. They are all deeply aware of the frustration experienced by their membership and are working hard in their evenings and weekends, on top of working full time in their classrooms, to try and figure out a way forward. This is made even more difficult by the fact that easyREG is a small company with limited staffing.


