A high-level scan of BCTF News displays an ongoing pattern of overcrowded classrooms, teacher shortages, upswings in violence, lack of supports and some imminent job actions in other provinces. Reporting is additionally very much starting to manifest as a real concern here, as inadequate support meets tight timelines and high expected efforts by teachers.

On top of this, the tragedy at Hazel Trembath continues to resonate within the community and outside of it as well. The needs here continue and will likely do so for the foreseeable future. On that point, the outpouring of support continues to tangibly manifest in the school site. The support will continue to be needed and we are always working to ensure the needs of the school are being met.

All in all, a very high stress time to be in teaching. Based on the troubled and complex matters we are dealing with down here at the CTA this is very much showing itself to us as well. We want to offer support to the teaching community at the CTA and we very much welcome the additional help brought to us by Ronak Pahlevanlu, who is stepping into a secondment here as temporary Labour Relations Officer. Congratulations and gratitude is extended here; we really need the help.

Negotiations Committee


Our Collective Agreement is up for re-negotiation in 2025, and a new Negotiations Committee is required.


