We Are All CTA Members

The teacher shortage is undoubtedly impacting us all on a regular basis and contributing to an already busy workload. While the CTA is doing what we can to engage the employer in problem solving options, there are considerations that we all need to keep in mind.

Preserving prep time might mean a colleague in learning services at your site doesn't get time to support children or youth on their caseload. Preserving service time might mean a colleague loses their prep without

certainty of when they will recover it. There is no perfect solution apart from hiring more teachers so we are not in a shortage. What we must remember is that we are all CTA members. We are all teachers doing our best to support each other and our communities in a system that isn't providing enough. When we share our frustrations around failures to fill, shortages, and the impacts those things have, we must remember that none of our colleagues chose to lose their prep or their service time. None of them had their workload reduced to accommodate the additional work that providing coverage creates, rather they were left to somehow complete all their tasks and work with less time.

In talking about the things that frustrate us and seeking a solution to this complex problem we shouldn't devalue our colleagues' work by suggesting that the work of any CTA member is less important than another. The work of our learning services, non-enrolling, Winslow, and Mentoring colleagues is often less visible, but is by no means less important or valued than the work of other CTA members. We are a union of professionals and we owe each other the respect that entails. The CTA is a proud collective of teachers, all doing our best in a difficult situation. This is the time for us to come together and support each other, recognizing that the source of this problem lies with the government, not our colleagues.



Negotiations Committee


Our Collective Agreement is up for re-negotiation in 2025, and a new Negotiations Committee is required.
