You will explore built-in and free reading and writing tools to support literacy. When working on a laptop, these built-in tools allow students to access information, make annotations, create and edit their own writing. Some supports include: dictation, predictive text, text-to-speech online and in Word, annotation of PDFs for assignment completion, and the reduction of visual distractions from websites. These tools align with the principles of UDL as they will benefit all students. Come explore them with us.

TRIUMF is Canada's particle accelerator centre. From the hunt for the smallest particles in the universe to the development of new technologies, including next-generation batteries and medical isotopes, TRIUMF is pushing the frontiers in research to advance science, medicine, and industry.

Visual and augmented reality experiences take you to CERN and "behind the fence" at TRIUMF. Experience what a researcher does at the CERN-based ATLAS experiment, one of the world's largest particle detectors and at TRIUMF, the world's largest cyclotron that is near UBC.

Participants do not need to bring anything. 2 VR headsets will be provided for the session.


