

This 90-minute Pre-D workshop explores how the effective and intentional use of AI can help educators plan for all learners through differentiation and Universal Design for Learning. Participants will examine how AI supports planning, assessment, and resource creation while preserving valuable face-to-face time with students. We will also discuss strategies for crafting effective plans and share real examples of how AI has enhanced our work in both K-12 and post-secondary education. By integrating AI thoughtfully, educators can meet students where they are, adapting instruction in real time while maintaining the human connections that define meaningful teaching and learning.

Lauren and Terai are experienced educators passionate about inclusive, student-centered teaching. Lauren has nearly 30 years of experience in middle and secondary education, specializing in science and math, and believes in cross-curricular learning that connects ideas meaningfully. They both believe in the power of relationships, and the BC Core Competencies as foundations for effective learning. 
